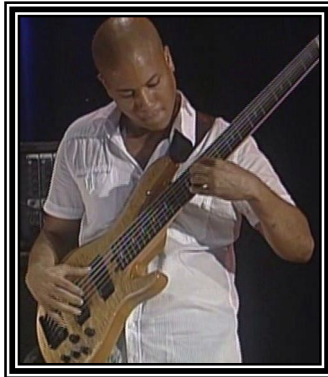


Professor

EDUCATION ; BACKGROUND ; EXPERIENCE :

1996 - Born in Havana, Cuba, Professor Miranda began his musical studies in the Escuela Elemental de Música Adolfo Guzmán, specializing in guitar.

1997 – 1999 – participated and received several awards in the Festival Infantil de Guitarra Isaac Nicola.

2003 – Toured throughout Germany, Denmark, Poland, Italy, Greece, Czechoslovakia, Slovenia and Austria with the Compañía de Teatro Buendía playing bass and percussions as well as a composer and arranger.

2004 - 2005 – Graduated from the Conservatorio Municipal de Música Amadeo Roldan with a major in Electric Bass and Double Bass and later participated in the International Festival for Young Jazz Artists, placing second in the under 21 category.

2005 – Participated in Festival de Teatro in Bogotá, Colombia and joined the Jazz Band Gigante directed by Maestro Jorge Luís Triana who offered a concert in the inauguration of Festival JOJAZZ.

2006 – 2007 - Invited by Chucho Valdés to play with the Gala Mayor Quartet in the inauguration of the Jazz Plaza Festival. In July of that same year performed in his first concert and his second in 2007 performing two original unedited themes in the Auditorium del Museo Nacional de Bellas Artes.

Professor Miranda has participated in diverse groups performing in jazz clubs such as the Zorra; the Cuervo; and the Jazz Café. He has also composed and arranged themes for the Gala Mayor Trio and performed in numerous concerts and shared the stage with, among others, Lynn Milanés. The professor has also performed with the orchestra in the Cabaret Parisién in the Hotel Nacional de Cuba under the direction of Maestro Osmundo Calzado.

Professor Miranda has studied music composition in the Instituto Superior del Arte for 4 years after which he joined the world-renowned group NG La Banda under the direction of Maestro José Luis Cortes. He has also performed salsa with Jaime Cuadra; Julio Sabala; and Manolin El Medico Turing his tour with NG La Banda.

Professor Miranda currently teaches Electric Bass Guitar and Double Bass, performs with various groups and dedicates much time to electronic music composition.
