EDUCATION:

Professor Diana Diaz graduated from the Music Conservatory of the Faculty of the Arts, National University of Colombia with a Degree in Musical Pedagogy with emphasis on Piano and Vocal Techniques. Her musical educational at the Conservatory continued under internationally recognized Colombian Professors such as Pablo Alvarez, Ana Rita Salazar, Mireya Arboleda and Russian Professor Tatiana Pavlova. Professor Diaz later earned a Masters Degree in Broadcasting and Television and Radio Production.
